	1	With 1:33 remaining on the game clock in the 4th period, B1 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on A1 who is dribbling in his backcourt. Team A is granted a time-out. After 2 free throws, the game shall be resumed with team A throw-in at the centre line extended.	YES	NO
	2	A shot for a field goal ends when the ball touches the ring.	YES	NO
	3	The playing court is 28 m x 15 m measured from the inside edge of the boundary line.	YES	NO
	4	The game consists of 4 periods of 12 minutes.	YES	NO

	10	A1 penetrates to the basket and while in the air, A1 makes an illegal contact with his leg on B1 who is in a legal guarding position with one foot inside the semi-circle. This is an offensive foul.	YES	NO
